Your child will be taking the Ohio Achievement Assessments during the week of April 29th.

The assessment schedule will be:

Monday, April 29 - Reading: Grades 5 & 8
Tuesday, April 30 - Reading: Grades 6 & 7
Wednesday, May 1 - Math: Grades 5 & 8
Thursday, May 2 - Math: Grades 6 & 7
Friday, May 3 - Science: Grades 5 & 8

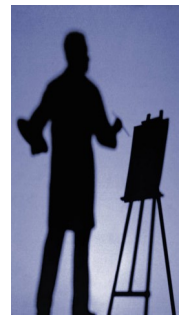
Please do not schedule any appointments during the school day so that your child is at school every day to complete these tests. Also please be sure that your child gets enough rest each night and has eaten a healthy breakfast each morning. The school will also be providing breakfast each morning for those students taking the test. Encourage your child to do his/her best on these tests. The testing period will be two and one-half hours. The Ohio Department of Education expects a minimum of 75% passage rate on each test. Results of the Ohio Achievement Assessments will be used to place students in the advance classes. Students will be bringing home a contract for parents to sign. The results will be shared with you when they arrive.
