## *Message from the Superintendent*



The Crestview Board of Education will have a new face when it convenes for the organizational meeting in January. Dave McGoogan, was elected to fill the vacant seat created when long-time Board member Dave Vollnogle decided not to seek a fifth term. Dave McGoogan and his wife Allyson reside on Bonesville School Road, Leetonia, Ohio with their two sons Josh, who was a 2015 Crestview graduate and is currently enrolled in STEM Engineering program at YSU, and Dale who is currently in 8<sup>th</sup> grade at Crestview Middle School. Dave is employed as an Electrician Instructor for YJATC and is an Elder at the Victory Christian Center.

In addition to Dave McGoogan, Jim Weikart was re-elected to his 4<sup>th</sup> term on the Board of Education and Brayden Tucker was re-elected to his second term. Brayden Tucker is also still serving on his first term as the Crestview Representative to the Columbiana County Career and Technical Center Board of Education.

In December, Dave Vollnogle will be completing his 16<sup>th</sup> year on the Board of Education. During his tenure on the Board, Dave has served as President; Vice-President and at one time on all of the standing committees of the Board. As a Board Member, Dave has provided leadership in many of the district projects including, the implementation of soccer and wrestling as varsity sports, the renovation of the stadium, the construction of soccer fields; the implementation of the S.T.E.M. curriculum; the implementation of open enrollment at Crestview, and the construction of the Performing Arts Center. Although Dave will now be absent from the Crestview Board of Education, he plans to still stay active in Crestview School activities. Dave feels that by stepping down from the Crestview Board of Education, it will provide him more time to be involved in the other service organizations in which he is a member.

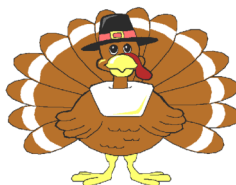
## Elementary Testing Schedule for Grades 2, 3 & 4
