Parents, guardians and the Community Service Committee must approve the activity. Students should work toward a goal of 25 community service hours each year of high school. **Students should be earning community service hours during the summer!!!!**


PARKING PERMITS

Student drivers **must purchase** a parking permit for the 2016-2017 school year. The permits will be issued on a first come-first served basis beginning August 2, 2016. Student Parking Forms are available online and in the high school office. Students must have the forms **signed by their parents, bring proof of insurance and \$25.00** to purchase a parking permit. Permits will be issued to students with the proper paperwork. All student drivers must have a parking pass and will follow the Crestview drug testing policy .

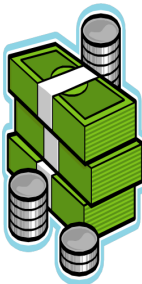
