## *Message from the Superintendent*

Dear Rebel Nation:



Hats off to the best community on the planet. The world is facing a huge challenge, but there is also an opportunity to demonstrate the good in people. We can all live the Golden Rule, especially now. We can easily show we care by staying home!! We will protect ourselves and our neighbors! However, while we protect them, we must not isolate them. We can call or video chat to protect from loneliness. We can shop for the most at risk or take their garbage can down their driveway. I had a wise person tell me recently to, "keep it simple!"

I am so proud of all of you. Our families have more responsibility for learning as we connect from home. Please do not feel isolated with this, because our teachers are available from 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. daily. I cannot thank all our staff enough for reinventing themselves so quickly. We are doing something that is unprecedented. I also cannot thank our classified staff enough. We are serving over 478 breakfasts and 478 lunches daily. You may still call in and pick up food daily between 11:00 - 12:30 p.m. by calling 330-482-5526. Our delivery routes have been established and are closed at this time. Food is FREE for any student. Our superb kitchen staff and superb bus drivers have taken this on as a mission of service. Thank you all; our staff is simply awesome!

At the end of March, the Ohio Legislature passed some revisions for this year. In short, common sense was used and the state waved a ton of student requirements as we work to conquer this unusual pandemic. Here are the key educational elements!

- **Class of 2020** - Graduation requirements waived - Local decision: you must have your credits as determined by administration
- **3rd Grade Reading Guarantee** - Waived - Local Decision: pass your daily school work and you will be ok
- We are allowed to use distance learning and packets for as long as ordered by the State
- No state Graded Report Card for Ohio Schools. Students will still have their own individual report card from their classes
- Crestview has no eligible ED Choice Schools
- Board meetings are allowed to be streamed and held in a virtual environment

We also would like to give a shout out to our nurses and science teachers. We have shipped all latex gloves, masks, goggles, and rubbing alcohol to the Health Department and Emergency Management. We all need to support our first responders as they battle a virus like no other. We all are partners in the success of our community, state, nation, and world. We thank our first responders for all their care.

During the last two weeks we have had many questions. We will be honest and tell you we may not know. There have been days that we posted something and an hour later it changed. If you need us, we are available from 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. daily. The office phones are forwarded to the secretaries at home. Also, you may email staff and they will be in touch with you. You are not alone, we are here to help.

# Middle School & High School News

## 12th GRADE IMMUNIZATIONS 2020

Immunization Requirements for students entering 12th grade in the fall of 2020: Students are required to have:

**2 doses of meningococcal (serogroup A, C, W and Y) vaccine.**

If your child received the first dose of the vaccine after his/her 16th birthday, a second (2nd) dose is not required.

## 7th GRADE IMMUNIZATIONS FALL 2020

Immunization Requirements for students entering 7th grade in the fall of 2020: Students are required to have the following immunizations:

**1 dose of Tdap Vaccine**

**1 dose of meningococcal (serogroup A, C, W and Y) vaccine**

We must have proof of these immunizations in order for your child to begin 12th grade. If your child has already received these immunizations, please send a copy of the record to the school as soon as possible. If your child has not received these immunizations, please contact your healthcare provider as soon as possible to schedule an appointment. It is important to plan ahead as it may be difficult to get an appointment closer to the start of school in the fall. The Immunization Record must be received before August 24, 2020. Records can be mailed, faxed (330-482-5369) or hand delivered to the office. Please contact Janet Leipheimer, school nurse, at 330-482-4744 Ext. 40117 with any questions regarding these new requirements.

## WASHINGTON, D.C. REFUNDS

Unfortunately, the 8th grade Washington, D.C. trip has been cancelled for this school year. Mrs. Nappi and Mrs. Lemaster will work together to plan a trip for these students next school year. Refunds will be issued, in the amount you paid to the school, via a check from Crestview Local Schools. ## 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR SCHEDULING FOR CURRENT GRADES 8-11

Students currently in grades 8 - 11 should have already accessed Mr. Miller's CHS Guidance Counselor webpage to review the Curriculum Handbook, and completed the appropriate Google Form for their grade level next year as of 3/30/2020. A student who plans to take CCP classes or attend the CCCTC should still complete a full schedule at Crestview, then once the student has been accepted into appropriate programs and classes, the Crestview schedule will be adjusted to fit their specific scheduling requirements. ## Kindergarten Screening Postponed & Rescheduled for August 5, 2020

It is not too late to register your child for Crestview Kindergarten. Kindergarten registration and screening has been rescheduled for Wednesday, August 5 from 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. in the elementary Gym. This will be our only registration/screening day, so please try to be available on that day. Parents are asked to go online and complete the required enrollment forms at [crestviewlocal.esvportal.com/login](http://crestviewlocal.esvportal.com/login) or go to our school website, [crestviewrebels.org](http://crestviewrebels.org) and select FORMS & LINKS and OneView Parent Portal. The following documents are required on August 5th to register your child:

- Student's original birth certificate
- Student's immunization records from your doctor (Immunizations must be present on registration day and all required immunizations and school physicals must be up to date prior to school entry)
- Student's social security number
- Parent/Guardian driver's license or ID
- Proof of Parent/Guardian residency with YOUR name and address - i.e. utility bill
- Custody papers (if applicable) Ohio State Law requires this to be on file.

Parents will then receive pre-registration confirmation and a scheduled appointment time via e-mail. To be eligible for Kindergarten your child must be five years old prior to September 30, 2020. State law requires kindergarten experience prior to attending first grade. If you do not have access to a computer, or need help with the registration process, please call 330-482-5370, Option 4.

## Learning at Home Tips for Elementary Families

Because of the current COVID-19 pandemic, students and families are following Ohio Governor Mike DeWine's order to stay at home through April 2020. Teachers are remotely working to provide lessons and resources for students. As this is a new process for all of us, here are a few tips to help ease anxieties at this time:



- Ideally, it's best to maintain a daily routine for doing schoolwork, Monday through Friday. Students should complete chunks of work daily rather than trying to get it all done at once.
- Encourage your children to do their best on their schoolwork, both paper/pencil and online, but do not let it become an ugly monster that creates additional drama at home. Set daily expectations for students and reward them for small victories as they complete small chunks of their schoolwork.
- Let students know that schoolwork is their job. Parents should not be doing the work for their children. Parents jobs are encouragement and support.
- Parents can model staying calm as they help students problem solve certain aspects of their schoolwork.
- Families should reach out to teachers when they get stuck or when clarification is needed. Teachers can be reached via email, Classroom DoJo, Remind or phone. The school phone number is 330-482-5370, if you are having trouble reaching a particular teacher.
